

SFFSN FAMILY SUPPORT STANDARDS

STAFF SELF-REFLECTION CHECKLIST

This tool is designed for staff to use as reminder of applying the SFFSN Family Support Standards in their daily work with families. Staff are encouraged to keep it in a place they will see every day.



1. Do I do my best to schedule with families at a time and place convenient to them?
2. Do I interact with families in a welcoming and respectful way?
3. Do I recognize and affirm families' strengths?
4. Do I remember to invite other/multiple family members to participate in services and activities?
5. Do I ask about and listen to what a participant says about their needs and those of their family members?
6. Do I make sure that families get the internal and external resources to address their needs?
7. Do I facilitate opportunities for families to build relationships with other families?
8. Am I sensitive to and affirm families' diversity, including cultural traditions, values, socio-economic status, family structures and individual abilities?
9. Do I build relationships with service providers and/or community groups to share resources and information?
10. Do I support families to advocate for themselves to address their needs?
11. Do I ask about and listen to families' feedback and ideas about the Program?
12. Do I share the feedback of ideas of families with other staff/managers?
